The Christmas program at the school went great. The students and the teachers were very attentive to both the play and the message! It is always such a pleasure to present the Gospel in the schools!

We had hoped to do a Christmas program for the whole prison, but we were only given permission to do it for a group of 56 men. We also weren't allowed to take in women and children, so we had to change the play! Richard, Matthew, and Joshua did a smaller version of the play by themselves. It worked out great. Many of the men seemed to be under conviction. At the end of the program, one of the prisoners read a letter that he had written to us. In it he thanked us for coming each week to teach them about God. He said that other people treat them as though they are just evil people, but that we treat

them as friends and show them love. He was almost in tears as he read it, and so were we! We thank God that we can be here to show His love to them!
