One day in July after an unusually difficult morning of trying to get kids to behave both while doing the van route and during children's church, Kristi was taking kids home from church. She felt like the morning had not gone well. Then, one of the boys in the car began to ask her lots of questions about salvation and how to go to Heaven. He had been listening that morning after all! He said he wanted to be saved. She pulled the car over and he got saved! He went home so excited to tell his dad! Then, the next Sunday the other two boys who had been in the car that day got saved too! Even on the difficult days, God is working!

Thai Mother's Day was in August. We had a really special service. We had a dinner for the ladies, and Mrs. Tracy Trask from Trenton, Georgia spoke to us through video. She was such an encouragement! We had a good turn out in spite of rain. We had Thai, Burmese, Filipino, Karen, and American ladies.

We have a big project we are working on that we would like you to help us pray about. We have been renting the building we use as a church and our house for 13 years. We really love it here, but we long to be able to buy a church building so that the church expenses will be lower. We have tried to save for it, but there just has never been that much money. Then Richard got some inheritance. We began to look at property to see if it might be enough, but property was higher than we thought. Then a few weeks ago, we became aware of some property five kilometers out of town that was being sold for a good price. After much prayer, we feel like God wants us to buy it. We will be buying two acres. We will use part of it to build a small house for ourselves, then part of it to build a church, and part of it will hopefully be a cemetery. Please pray that everything about the purchase will go smoothly. Pray for us to have wisdom in each step of this project. Also pray that we will be able to get permission from the government to put a cemetery on the property. Since Thai people usually cremate, cemeteries are few and far between. We were blessed to be able to bury our children only 40 minutes away, but Christians often have to drive hours away for burials. Our church members are really excited to think we could have a cemetery at our church.
