Another year has passed by so quickly and we are very busy as usual for this time of year. Last month we handed out around 2,000 tracts at a Buddhist festival. It was the first time since the Covid restrictions to have such a big event here. We have been getting more new interest in the English class and a few visitors to church. After such a long pandemic, we are really thankful that people are more willing to take tracts again and begin coming to the church. Thank you for praying about this.

Last Friday, we had a cookout for all the dads for Thai Father's Day. We were thankful to have a couple of visitors come. It is definitely difficult to get men to come to church, so we were especially thankful to get this one man to come. We hired him to mow the church yard, but he is lost, and doesn't seem interested in knowing Jesus. He came and heard the Gospel! Please pray for him to be saved.

We will begin our Christmas programs in schools next week. We will be having programs in three schools. Last year they didn't allow church members to go along because of Covid restrictions, but this year they can go again. Please pray for the students and staff to understand the true meaning of Christmas and to come to know the Savior whose birthday we celebrate.

The Christmas program at church will be on December 16th. Before Covid over a hundred people would come for the Burmese night and around 100 for the Thai night, but since then it has been mostly just church members. Please help us pray that many visitors will come this year.

We had to replace our transmission. The mechanic put in a rebuilt transmission, but the car has been having problems ever since. He has now removed it and is waiting for another one. Please pray for us about this car problem. Thankfully we have our van also, but we really need both vehicles for picking up people for church.

We are very excited that our children, son and daughter-in-laws, and grandchildren will be coming to visit us for Christmas! We rarely ever get to have everyone in the same place at once. Please pray for them to travel safely.

May God bless each of you with a wonderful Christmas and happy new year. We are thankful for your help in the ministry here.
