We are so thankful for all of you prayer warriors. We have an important prayer request. A few weeks ago, Kristi began having terrible chest pains on the left side. A chest x-ray showed a shadow on her lung. The doctor thought it was a blood clot on the lung, but it wasn't. She was diagnosed with severe pneumonia, even though she had no other symptoms. Thankfully, the pain went away. She took antibiotics, but three weeks later the x-ray was worse. She had a CT scan and a bronchoalveolar lavage procedure to obtain a sample of the mucus in her lungs. Though the doctors were looking for many serious things, such as cancer and tropical diseases, we got good news yesterday. It isn't either of those. It may be bacterial or fungal. It also could just be mucus that is stuck in the lung. It will be six more weeks to get all of the lab results. Thankfully, she is feeling okay and not in any pain. Pray we will find out what it is, and pray for healing. Also, the concussion and jaw fracture she had from a fall in July have healed. Thanks for praying for that and please pray for her right lung.

Now for some better news... God has been blessing our ministry. A new family started coming to church about a month ago, and the husband got saved last Sunday. Please pray for the wife. We have had quite a few visitors, and we've seen God working in the lives of the church members.

Also, in our last letter we asked prayer about starting a new church in a city an hour away. We rented a very small building that is in a very visible area. Although it is small, the rent is reasonable and it is in a good location. We will begin with English classes with Bible classes afterwards. We will have a church service there one evening each week to start with. Please pray for us to win souls in Sukhothai as well as Tak! We already have another location that we want to start a work in as well. It is half way between the two locations, there are no churches in the town, and there is a perfect building for rent across from a school on the main road. Please help us to pray for God's will about this. We want to be sure of His timing.
